- The first stop will be at Everard Read gallery or their sister space, CIRCA gallery at the V&A Waterfront. This is the oldest commercial gallery in South Africa. They are known to showcase established contemporary artists as well as the emerging younger generations.
- Guild gallery is next, this gallery is the only design gallery in South Africa, established by the internationally acclaimed design duo Trevyn and Julian McGowan. Annually the very best local designers, artists, architects, and upcoming talents are invited to produce and premier original pieces for the Southern Guild collection that year.
- Then the Goodman gallery in De Waterkant who is well known for their internationally acclaimed cutting edge and political activist artists. The alternative is the newly opened Deepest Darkest gallery.
- After that, we will stop at one of the smaller galleries in the city centre that represents mid-career to more established artist's work, for example: Worldart, 99 Loop, Salon 91, Christopher Moller or Ebony Curated.
- Lunch in the city centre
- We will end the day in Woodstock known as the fringe art area of Cape Town - stopping along the Fairweather House, Stevenson gallery, Blank Projects or the SMAC gallery. More so we can pop by Bronze Age Foundry or the Bijou.
