LUNCH

We stop for lunch in Rosebank at either Marble or Momo Kuro. Momo Kuro is known for its entrance through a 'secret' stairwell and the décor is modern and minimalist with wrap-around glass windows affording some of the best views in Jozi.



AFTERNOON

Some of the galleries that may be visited include: Stevenson Gallery - Showcasing cutting-edge South African contemporary art and photography, Stevenson is known for its provocative and thought-provoking contemporary exhibitions and installations by young South African artists.

• Everard Read - First established on a dusty street of Johannesburg in 1913, when it was a young mining town, this is Africa's oldest commercial art gallery. The gallery moved from Johannesburg's city centre to its current location in the late 1970's and the present building is a celebrated icon of South African post-modern architecture. Everard Read Gallery has a full annual calendar of new exhibitions and showcases many top South African artists and sculptors. Across the road is sister gallery, the contemporary landmark Circa Gallery. Special sundowners can be arranged here (additional costs apply) in the beautiful entertainment space, on the rooftop of Circa gallery. Intimate artist interactions are also possible subject to availability and additional costs.

• SMAC Gallery - Representing both emerging and established South African, African and international artists, SMAC Gallery is one of South Africa's most renowned contemporary art galleries with locations in Cape Town, Stellenbosch and Johannesburg. The Joburg gallery, located in the Trumpet building, is the newest space, hosting memorable exhibitions by an exciting line-up of local and international artists.

• Goodman Gallery - One of the country's leading galleries, the gallery's focus is on African and diaspora artists who engage in a dialogue with the African context. Among some of the most famous artists represented by the gallery are William Kentridge, Sam Nhlengethwa and Haroon Gunn-Salie.

The order of galleries visited, will greatly depend on your lunch venue, and these spaces can easily be viewed within 20-30min. There are also many interesting smaller galleries that can be included depending on the interests of the clients.
