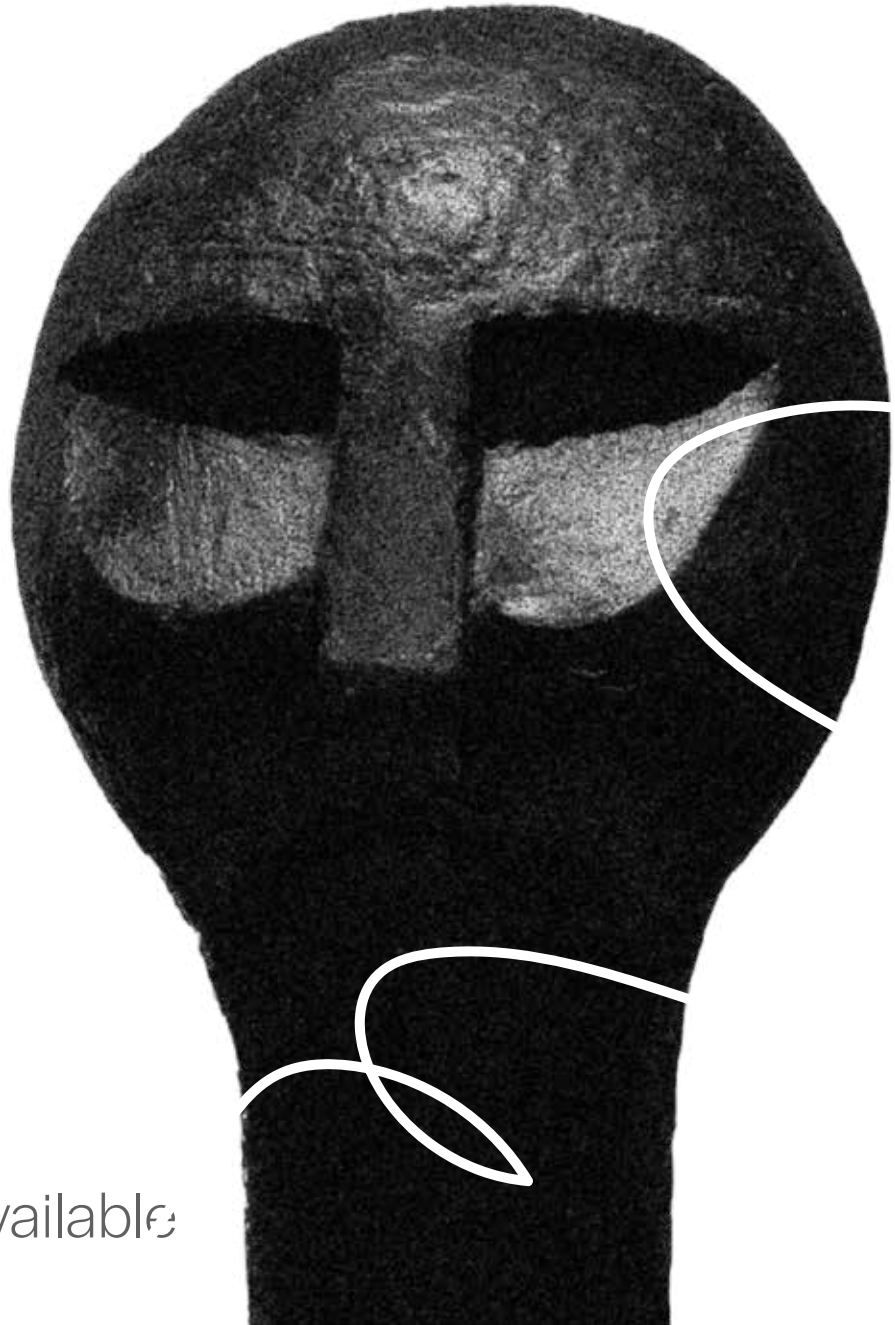

## **Wits Art Museum**

Home to the largest & most significant holdings of African arts in southern Africa. The collection is made up of different sub-collections which were added at various times in the Museum's history. It also houses Jack Ginsburg Centre for Art Books. Earliest works included probably date to the 4th century C.E. Most works date from the 20th & 21st centuries.

12 000 items: the three major collecting areas of classical, historical and contemporary artworks are unique in their breadth, geographical range & local specialisation.

There is significant depth to the collections of beadwork, drums, headrests, wooden sculpture, ceremonial and fighting sticks, masks, basketry, wirework and textiles. The objects have been assembled primarily in recognition of their aesthetic value.

## **Johannesburg Art Gallery**

Built over 100 years ago, the Johannesburg Art Gallery is the oldest museum of its kind in the city, and boasts a collection of over 10 000 artworks.

In addition to robust historical & Southern African cultural collections, the 'JAG' as it is affectionately known, also houses a growing contemporary collection.

Exhibitions run for an average of 3 months and showcase works from the collections as well as work from local and international contemporary artists.

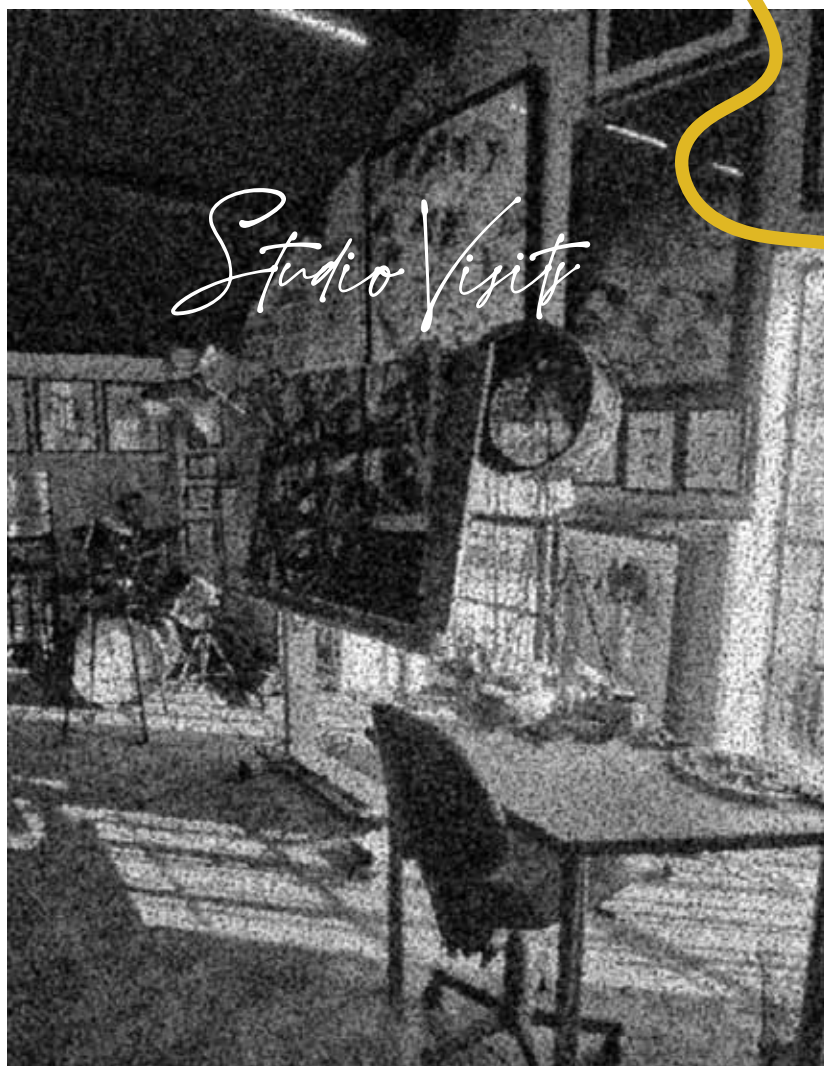
