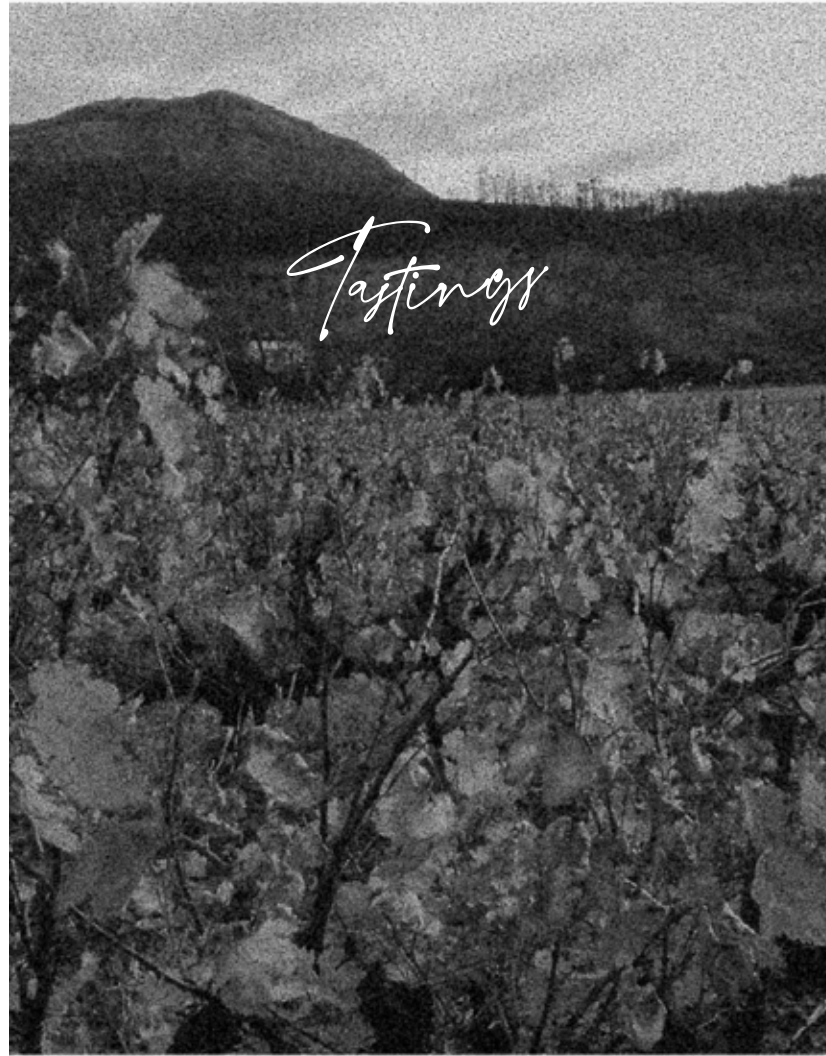

## La Motte

The La Motte Museum not only offers displays depicting aspects of the Rupert family, focusing on Dr. Anton and Mrs. Huberte Rupert and the musical career of their daughter Hanneli Rupert, but also features the history of La Motte and its magnificently renovated buildings, with a brief review of Cape Dutch architecture.

Permanent host to the heritage collection of Jacob Hendrik Pierneef, the museum also presents other temporary exhibitions.



# Rupert Museum

A unique & private art collection started by the Late Dr Anton Rupert & his wife Huberte Rupert in the 1940s. A South African businessman, philanthropist and conservationist, Anton Rupert, together with his wife, Huberte, were prominent figures in support of the visual arts, as well as promoting education, music and the preservation of historical buildings.

The inspiration for the museum has its origin in a fire at the Ruperts' home, following which, Huberte Rupert made the decision to create an art museum which would provide an intimate experience of their extensive art collection.

Today, this world-class collection by South African artists continues to grow and develop within the Rupert Art Foundation.

It now boasts a café, art workshop studio and beautifully landscaped indigenous garden. It is designed in the traditional 'Boland farm architecture' style, providing a cool space with simple clean white-washed walls. It's set among vineyards and oak trees along the Eerste River and complements the architectural history and wine culture of the area.



# The Norval Foundation

In late 2021, Boschendal launched a satellite gallery at its historic Manor House, hosting rotating exhibitions featuring notable African artists. Facilitated by Elana Brundyn, then CEO of Norval Foundation, the collaboration aimed to create a renowned art destination showcasing museum-quality exhibitions and historic as well as contemporary artistic practices.

In 2022, Elana founded Brundyn Arts and Culture, an art consultancy offering specialised services to museums, NGOs, individuals, corporations, and creatives. This partnership continued with Boschendal under her consultancy. Brundyn Arts and Culture stands out with two distinct exhibition spaces: one at their Cape Town offices and the other at Boschendal.

The space will continue to host museum-quality events and exhibitions, now with a commercial focus. Boschendal X Brundyn spotlights multidisciplinary artists from Southern Africa, its diaspora, and international practitioners. The gallery remains dedicated to developing a respected and engaging art programme that complements existing farm activities and initiatives.
